Despite the challenges, we met the task together, housing more families when they needed it most!

In 2020, this and more was accomplished!

- 25 families said goodbye to unstable housing and purchased brand new Habitat homes!
- Our 34-home Arbor Bend community was completed, filling an affordable housing need in south Apopka.
- 33 mentors are now on the rolls to give financial counseling to families trying to qualify for homeownership.
- 20 non-Habitat homes received critical repairs.
- 6 homes were built in 5 days during Builders Blitz.
