For six years, Habitat Orlando & Osceola has partnered with the building community to construct homes to help families become first-time homeowners. These key relationships help build up local neighborhoods and increase our mission's impact.

Now, we're expanding our partnership opportunities with Pro Build. This flexible and customizable program allows local builders to construct Habitat homes on a two- or four-week timeframe. Builders can customize their build to better suit their busy schedules - while still making a positive impact on Central Florida families.



Our Mission: Seeking to put God's love into action, Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope.

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Pro Build Timeline

Builder signs Letter of Intent (LOIs) with commitment to Habitat Orlando & Osceola.

- Builder begins to engage partners and subcontractors.

Three months out

- Builder assigns a project manager and notifies Habitat Orlando & Osceola.
- Builder makes commitments from partners and subcontractors.
- Habitat Orlando & Osceola hosts conference calls with project managers to review ongoing activities and protocol. Walk-throughs of building site scheduled.

Two months out

- Habitat Orlando & Osceola pulls permits.
- Builder begins site preparation activities and protocol.
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Four weeks out

- Site work commences (grading, staking and rough utilities)
- Insurance COI and vendor list must be provided to Habitat Orlando & Osceola.

Two weeks out

- Slab preparation is complete for event.

One week out

- Builder can install mobile storage unit on site.
- Habitat Orlando & Osceola staff will make daily site checks.

Habitat Orlando & Osceola responsibilities:

- Coordination of building permit process and sharing permit status with builder
- Inspection coordination
- Providing home plans and specifications
- Weekly conference calls and construction team logistics coordination.
- Site prep, including scraping and stakeout of the home on the lot
- Marketing plan coordination, including social media campaign, press releases, etc.
- Providing donated construction materials list.
- Tour of existing Habitat Orlando & Osceola homes as a point of reference

Builder responsibilities:

- Upon agreement, donation of the building of a home, signing of a letter of intent.
- Donate foundation and prep of lot prior to event start.
- Donate labor, materials and services to build a single-family home in the agreed upon time period.
- Engage subcontractors to donate services and products needed, based on the specifications provided by Habitat Orlando & Osceola.
- Review and comply with all specifications and standards to ensure all homeowners receive similar features in their new home.
- Provide food and beverages during the build for your trades.
- Provide on-site signage recognizing subcontractors.
- Provide a completed home with a one-year warranty.

Four weeks out:

- Meet your homeowner(s) in-person or via a teleconference program.



During the event:

- **Opening Ceremony:** A Habitat Orlando & Osceola staff member will kick-off your Pro Build with a special program that includes a fun send-off for your construction team.
- **Key Ceremony:** End your Pro Build with a touching ceremony that celebrates the end of your build - and the impact of your generosity.





Builder's Staff Involvement

Looking to get your staff involved during the build? Below are ideas that have been done in the past:

- Provide breakfast, lunch, or snacks to boost morale during the day.
- Make company-branded shirts for subcontractors.
- Ask your office staff to assist the build team by painting, cleaning or serving snacks.
- Take photos and videos throughout the build. Feel free to bring your own equipment and let us know in advance if you would like a Habitat Orlando & Osceola representative to be part of your footage. We will be capturing photos and videos each day as well.
- Share photos and videos on your social media channels to show the progress of your home.
- Provide a welcome basket for your homeowner with company-branded items such as doormats, shirts and welcome home banners.
