Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County partners with Enterprise Mobility to create more affordable housing in Central Florida

Orlando, Fla. (May 2, 2024) – In a continued partnership, <u>Habitat for Humanity Greater</u>
Orlando & Osceola County and volunteers from <u>Enterprise Mobility</u> came together to build a safe, affordable home. The organizations hung siding on a home in Holden Heights as part of the nonprofit's continued effort to combat the affordable housing crisis facing the Central Florida community.

"As Central Florida confronts the affordable housing crisis—made worse by inflation and supply chain challenges—community partners are essential to helping us Face The Housing Crisis," said Catherine Steck McManus, Habitat for Humanity Greater Orlando & Osceola County president & CEO. "Thank you to Enterprise Mobility Foundation for helping us continue to invest in building homes for the families of Central Florida."

Today's build marks the fifth time the two organizations have worked together since beginning a partnership in 2022. With nearly 20 employees on-site, Enterprise is helping to bring affordable housing options to the region.
